She is made to prostitute her body. A teenager migrates to the city, looking for work. He performs heavy labor for pennies. He sleeps with cockroaches. He almost starves, but he sends money to his family. Today we remember the plight of migrants. God, they are all your children. Help us, as Pope Benedict XVI calls us: to understand the causes of migration, to feel solidarity with those who migrate and to work for safety and justice for those who flee poverty and war. Amen.
